Kia ora whanau

Just recently we informed you all that we had whanau and a few students who have tested positive for Covid19 and are in isolation for ten days following the Ministry of Health guidelines.

The school is supporting this whanau to ensure they are receiving the care and support they need.

Since we sent out this notice our roll has dropped to nearly half. These whanau and students **do not have Covid and are not isolating,** it is because whanau are worried and concerned about sending their child to school.

We would however like to encourage you to send your child back to school for their learning as we have rigorous health and safety measures in place and research has shown that it's great for a child's wellbeing and learning to be at school with their friends and school staff.

Just to remind whanau your job as parent remains the same, too: please continue to keep a close watch of your whānau members for anyone with symptoms. If unwell, please stay at home, notify the school and get advice about getting a COVID-19 test.

Advice I received from the Ministry of Health and Education regarding schools who have been exposed to positive cases of Covid 19.

- carefully watch your children for any Covid19 symptoms and if they start to show keep your child at home.
- inform the school as soon as possible.
- contact your health professionals for guidelines and next steps.
- If no Covid signs your child can come to school.
- Remember the school is here to support you in any way we can.

If you have any concerns or queries, please feel free to contact us at school.

Our school is still open for learning on Monday 28th Feb 2022 for all children.

Do **You** have Covid 19? Do **You** live with someone who has Covid 19?

Did you spend time with someone in the last **48 hours** who now has Covid 19?

Do you live with someone who spent time with someone recently who has Covid 19?

You are a **POSITIVE CASE**, you need to self-isolate for 10 days.

Sorry, no school for you!

You are a **HOUSEHOLD CONTACT**, you need to self-isolate for 10 days, and get a test on **Day 3** and **Day 10**.

Still no school!

No worries! Come to school!

Monitor yourself for symptoms and **IF** they develop you will need to get a test.

You are all good!

Get to school!
